Dechreuodd y paratoadau ar gyfer cyngerdd heno gyda chlyweliadau yng Nghaerdydd a Llundain diwedd Ionawr a dechrau Chwefror 2020, pryd dewisiwyd gan y panel beirniaid chwech o gantorion i berfformio heno. Heno yr panel yn dewis un canwr i fynd ymlaen i gynrychioli Cymru yng nghystadleuaeth BBC Canwr y Byd Caerdydd ym Mehefin 2021. Yn ogystal bydd y canwr yn derbyn gwobr ariannol o £2,000, gyda'r pump canwr arall yn derbyn £750 er mwyn cynorthwyo gyda'u hastudiaethau pellach.

The preparations for this evening's concert began with auditions in Cardiff and London in late January and early February 2020, at which the panel of adjudicators selected the six singers who perform this evening. Tonight the panel will choose one singer to go forward to represent Wales in BBC Cardiff Singer of the World in June 2021. This singer will also receive a cash award of £2,000, and the other five singers will each receive £750 to assist future studies.

Mae Ferrando a Guglielmo wedi cytuno eu bod am brofi faint mae dyweddi’r ddau ohonynt yn eu caru drwy gymryd arnynt eu bod yn ymwelwyr o Albania a cheisio eu hudo. Tua diwedd Act 1, mae’r merched dal yn ffyddlon, ac mae Ferrando yn canu’r aria hon am gariad a all wrthsefyll popeth.

Ecco ridente in cielo. *Barber of Seville* Rossini

Ar ddechrau’r opera, mae’r larll Almaviva (mewn cuddwisg ac yn honni bod yn Lindoro, myfyriwr heb geiniog i’w enw) yn canu cân serch y tu allan i ffenest Rosina. Mae’n canu ynghylch toriad gwawr yn y ffurfafen lawen ac yn galw ar i’w anwylyd ddeffro a thawelu ing ei serch.

Avete torto!...Firenze è come un albero fiorito *Gianni Schicchi* Puccini

Mae Rinuccio mewn cariad â Lauretta, merch Gianni Schicchi. Mae ei deulu’n ei ddwrdio am feddwl priodi merch ceiliog dandi o werinwr anwybodus ond dywed Rinuccio eu bod yn ei methu hi, bod Schicchi yn beniog ac yn gyfarwydd â’r gyfraith ac mewn lle i roi cymorth iddyn nhw ddatrys problem ewyllys un o’u perthnasau. Cana am Firenze fel coeden yn ei blodau, yn dwyn ei nerth o wreiddiau eang.

Halt! *Die schöne Müllerin D795 no.3* Schubert

Mae ‘Morwyn Dlos y Felin’ yn gylch o ganeuon a osodwyd ar gyfer cerddi Wilhelm Müller. Cyrhaedda’r teithiwr y felin, gyda’i olwyn ddŵr swnllyd yn boddï swŵn y nant fyrlymog. Mae’n mynegi ei edmygedd o’r tŷ, a’i ffenestri sy’n disgleirio yng ngolau’r haul.

Yn ‘Yr Ymholydd’, mae’r teithiwr yn holi i’r nant fud roi ateb iddo – ai ‘ie’ ynteu ‘na’. Mae mewn cariad â merch y melinydd – ond a yw hi yn ei garu yntau hefyd? Ai anwiredd a lefarodd ei galon wrtho?

Love went ariding Bridge

Yng ngherdd Mary E Coleridge gwelir llun Cariad yn marchogaeth ar draws y wlad yn adfywio blodau ac yn dadmer ar afonydd fferllyd. Crefa glaslanciau a llancesi arno aros ond mae’n gwrthod gan fod gan Pegasus, y ceffyl mae’n ei farchogaeth, adenydd.

Mae’r tenor Cymreig Osian Wyn Bowen â’i wreiddiau yn nhref borthladd Porth Tywyn de Cymru. Graddiodd yn ddiweddar o Goleg Brenhinol Cerdd a Drama Cymru, Caerdydd lle bu’n astudio o dan oruchwyliaeth y tenor adnabyddus, Adrian Thompson.

Ymddangosodd Osian mewn opera am y tro cyntaf yn ddiweddar yn rhan ‘Jaquino’ o ‘Fidelio’ Beethoven gyda Chwmni Opera Cenedlaethol Cymru gan berfformio’r rhan dan oruchwyliaeth y cynhyrchydd Syr David Pountney a’r arweinydd Lothar Koenigs. Mae ei rannau operatig eraill yn cynnwys ‘Ferrando’ yn Cosi Fan Tutte, ‘Tamino’ a ‘Monostatos’ yn Y Ffliwt Hud, ‘Gonzalve’ yn L’heure Espagnole, ‘Y Brif Ran’ yn Albert Herring a ‘Marco’ yn The Gondoliers. Mae Osian wedi gweithio gyda rhai o hyfforddwyr ac arweinyddion amlyca’r byd yn cynnwys y maestro Carlo Rizzi a’r hyfforddwr lleisiol o fri bydeang, John Fisher.

Osian oedd enillydd gwobr Canwr Cymreig Ifanc y Flwyddyn MOCSA yn 2019 dan nawdd Côr Orffews Treforus. Ef hefyd yw derbynnydd diweddaraf cystadleuaeth cantorion Cymdeithas Gymreig Corau Meibion Cymru, gan gipio Gwobr Goffa Geraint Morris, yn ogystal â derbyn Ysgoloriaeth Minnie Morgan Cyngor Sir Caerfyrddin yn 2018 a 2019. Yn 2018, cyrhaeddodd Osian rownd derfynol Cystadleuaeth Cantorion Ifanc Gŵyl Gerdd Aberdaugleddau. Ym Mehefin 2019 cyrhaeddodd Osian rownd derfynol cystadleuaeth uchel ei bri ‘Gwobr Ian Stoutzker’ Coleg Breninol Cerdd a Drama Cymru.

Mae’n unawdydd cyngerdd poblogaidd gan ymddangos yn gyson fel artist gwadd ledled y DU.

Yn ystod haf 2021, bydd Osian yn ymddangos am y tro cyntaf gyda Garsington Opera yn canu rhan ‘Ein Tierhändler’ yng nghynhyrchiad y Cwmni o Der Rosenkavalier.

Ferrando and Guglielmo have agreed to test the love of their fiancées by disguising themselves as visiting Albanians and attempting to seduce them. Towards the end of Act 1 the girls are remaining steadfastly loyal, and Ferrando sings this aria about all-sustaining love.

At the beginning of the opera, Count Almaviva (disguised as Lindoro, a penniless student) offers a serenade under Rosina’s window. He sings of dawn breaking in the laughing heavens and calls on his beloved to wake up and soothe his agonies of love.

Rinuccio is in love with Lauretta, Gianni Schicchi’s daughter. His relatives berate him for contemplating marriage to the daughter of an ignorant upstart peasant, but Rinuccio says they are wrong, that Schicchi is clever and knows the law and can help them with the problem of a relative’s will. He sings that Florence is like a tree in flower, drawing its strength from farflung roots.

Halt! *Die schöne Müllerin D795 no.3* Schubert

‘The Fair Maid of the Mill’ is a song cycle set to poems by Wilhelm Müller. The traveller comes upon a mill, its noisy wheel drowning out the sound of the babbling brook. He admires the house, its windows gleaming in the sunlight.

Der Neugierige *Die schöne Müllerin D795 no.6* Schubert

In ‘The Inquirer’, the traveller addresses the silent brook and begs it to answer either ‘yes’ or ‘no’. He is in love with the miller’s daughter – but does she love him too? Has his heart lied to him?

Love went ariding Bridge

The figure of Love in Mary E Coleridge’s poem is seen riding across the land, bringing flowers to life and thawing the frozen rivers. Youths and maidens beg him to stay, but he refuses, as Pegasus, the horse he is riding, has wings.

Age: **24**

Welsh tenor, Osian Wyn Bowen originates from the harbour town of Burry Port, South Wales. A recent graduate of the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, Cardiff, Osian studies under renowned Tenor, Adrian Thompson.

Osian recently made his operatic debut with Welsh National Opera, performing the role of Jaquino in Beethoven’s ‘Fidelio’ under director Sir David Pountney and conductor Lothar Koenigs. Other operatic roles include, ‘Ferrando’ in Cosi Fan Tutte, ‘Tamino’ & ‘Monostatos’ in The Magic Flute, ‘Gonzalve’ in L’heure Espagnole, title role in Albert Herring and ‘Marco’ in The Gondoliers. Osian has worked with many of the world’s leading conductors and vocal coaches, notably maestro Carlo Rizzi and world renowned vocal coach John Fisher.

Osian was the 2019 Winner of the MOCSA Young Welsh Singer of the Year, held by the Morriston Orpheus Choir. In addition, he is also the latest recipient of the Welsh Association of Male Voice Choirs singers competition, winning the Geraint Morris Memorial Award, along with being the recipient of the Carmarthenshire County Council’s Minnie Morgan Scholarship 2018 & 2019. In 2018, Osian was a finalist in the Milford Haven Music Festival’s Young Opera Singers Competition. Osian was a finalist in the RWCMD’s prestigious competition, the ‘Ian Stoutzker Prize’ in June 2019.

In addition to this, he is also a popular concert soloist appearing regularly as a guest artist across the UK.

In the summer of 2021, Osian will make his company debut with Garsington Opera singing the role of ‘Ein Tierhändler’ in their production of Der Rosenkavalier.

Mae Rodelinda, brenhines Lombardi, yn credu ei bod yn wraig weddw. Mae Grimoaldo, trawsfeddianwr ei gŵr, yn awr yn holi iddi ei briodi. Mae Rodelinda yn cytuno, ar yr amod bod Grimoaldo yn lladd ei mab ger ei bron, gan na all briodi traws-feddianwr ac ar yr un pryd barhau i fod yn fam i etifedd cyfreithlon yr orsedd. Gŵyr hi y bydd hyn yn gwneud i Grimoaldo ymddangos yn anghenfil di-drugaredd, ac yn unigolyn na fydd hi byth yn medru ei gofleidio. Mae ef yn ymwrthod â'r dynged hon.

Eccomi in lieta vesta...O quante volte. *I Capuleti ed i Montecchi* Bellini

Mae Giulietta yn caru Romeo ond mae'n cael ei gorfodi i briodi Tebaldo. Yn ei gwisg briodas hardd mae'n teimlo fel ysglyfaeth yn barod i'w harwain at yr allor a byddai'n well ganddi gael ei haberthu na phriodi dyn nad yw'n ei garu. Mae'n dyheu am i Romeo ei hachub.

Temerari...Come scoglio *Così fan tutte* Mozart

Mae dau ddieithryn yn canlyn Fiordiligi a'i chwaer Dorabella - mewn gwirionedd eu cariadon dan gochl ydyn nhw. Fiordiligi, y fwyaf didderbyn-wyneb o'r ddwy chwaer, sy'n canu'r geiriau hallt grymus yma am ffyddlondeb, gan ddweud y bydd ei theyrngarwch yn gadarn fel y graig er gwaethaf unrhyw demtasiwn.

Rodelinda, queen of Lombardy, believes herself to be widowed. Grimoaldo, her husband's usurper, now proposes to her. Rodelinda agrees, on condition that Grimoaldo kills her son before her eyes, as she cannot marry an interloper and simultaneously be mother to the rightful heir to the throne. She knows that this will make Grimoaldo appear a monster, one that she will never be able to embrace. He recoils from this fate.

Giulietta loves Romeo, but is being forced to marry Tebaldo. In her beautiful wedding dress she feels like a sacrificial victim ready to be led to the altar, and would prefer to be sacrificed than married to a man she does not love. She longs for Romeo to come to her aid.

Fiordiligi and her sister Dorabella are being wooed by two strangers, who are actually their lovers in disguise. Fiordiligi, the more strongminded of the sisters, delivers this strong diatribe on fidelity, saying that she will remain firm as a rock in her loyalty, despite all temptations.

Welsh soprano Jessica Cale, winner of the 2020 Kathleen Ferrier Award, is in her final studies at the Royal College of Music International Opera Studio where she is the Robert Lancaster scholar. Jessica holds a Master of Performance with distinction from the Royal College of Music, and a First Class Honours degree from Cardiff University.

Jessica's operatic experience includes the roles of Flaminia (Haydn, *Il mondo della luna*); Susan (Berkeley, *A Dinner Engagement*); Second Bridesmaid (Mozart, *Le nozze di Figaro*); Despina (Mozart, *Così fan tutte*, Ryedale Festival Opera) and Serpetta (Mozart, *The Garden of Disguises*, Ryedale Festival Opera) and in RCM Opera Scenes: Blanche (*Dialogues des Carmélites*, Poulenc); Tina (*Flight, Dove*); Poppea (*L'incoronazione de Poppea*, Monteverdi); Juliette (*Roméo et Juliette*, Gounod); Musetta (*La Bohème*, Puccini); and Mélisande (*Pelléas et Mélisande*, Debussy).

Jessica has performed as a soloist for Sir John Eliot Gardiner in Mendelssohn's *A Midsummer Night's Dream* at the Barbican Centre; for Paul McCreech in Purcell's *King Arthur* and *Fairy Queen* with the Gabrieli Consort; and for Mark Padmore in Bach's *St Matthew Passion* across Europe with the Orchestra of the Age of the Enlightenment. Recent solo engagements include Mendelssohn's *Elijah* at the Berlin Philharmoniker and Handel's *Messiah* at the Royal Albert Hall. In 2020 Jessica was a finalist in the London Handel Festival International Singing Competition and in 2019 gained 2nd place in the Llangollen Eisteddfod Pendine International Voice of the Future Competition.

The Three Ladies have given Prince Tamino a locket with a miniature of Princess Pamina. He looks at the portrait and is captivated by Pamina's beauty.

Bleuet Poulenc

Bleuet - 'y glas bach' - yw'r gair Ffrangeg am y blodyn, glas yr yd. Bu hefyd yn air slang am y dynion rheini a recriwtiwyd i wasanaethu ym Myddin Ffrainc yn ystod y Rhyfel Byd Cyntaf, sef cyfeiriad at liw glaslwyd y wisg a wisgent amdanynt. Cafodd cerdd Apollinaire ei chyfansoddi ym 1917 ac ynddi cyfeirir at filwr 20-mlwydd oed. Er mor ifanc y mae, gwelodd gymaint. Apollinaire's poem was written in 1917 and is addressed to a 20-year-old soldier. He is so young, yet has seen so much. Bravery and cunning surround him, but he knows death better than life and will know how to die as he goes over the top into battle.

Kuda, kuda, kuda vy udalilis *Eugene Onegin* Tchaikovsky

Mae Lensky wedi herio Onegin i ymladd gornest wedi i Onegin fflyrtio gyda'i anwylyd, Olga. Mae'n disgwyl am ymddangosiad ei wrthwynebydd ac yn canu am ei ieuencid a natur anochel ffawd. Dim ond ei gariad taug at Olga sy'n rhoi gobaith iddo.

Lensky has challenged Onegin to a duel after Onegin flirted with his beloved Olga. He waits for his rival and sings of his youth and the inevitability of fate. Only his love for Olga gives him hope.

Che gelida manina *La bohème* Puccini

Nosily Nadolig daeth Mimì, y wnaidwraig, i fyny'r grisiau i aflood Rodolfus, yn chwilio am dân i'w channwyll. Mae'n gollwng ei gorriad yn y tywyllwch; caiff Rodolfo hyd iddo ac fel y cyffrdda eu dwylo mae'n sylwi bod ei llaw fach yn iasoer. Mae'n nhw'n syrthio mewn cariad.

On Christmas Eve, Mimì, a seamstress, has come to her neighbour Rodolfo's garret, looking for a light for her candle. She drops her key in the dark; Rodolfo finds it and as their hands touch, he notices how icily cold her little hand is. They fall in love.

Mae’n galw ar ei chariad i beidio ag oedi ac i ddod i’w chyfarfod yn y llwyni rhosod.

Das Rosenband Strauss Op. 36. no. 1

Yn ‘Y rhuban rhosynnau’, mae’r canwr yn dod o hyd i’w gariad, yn cysgu yng nghysgod y gwanwyn. Mae’n ei chlymu mewn rhubanau lliw rhosyn ac yn syllu arni wrth iddi gysgu. Mae’n sibrwd wrthi ac yn ysgwyd y rhubanau. Pan mae’n deffro ac yn syllu arno, mae ef yn y nefoedd. Mae’r gerdd gan Klopstock.

O légère hirondelle *Mireille* Gounod

Mae Mireille yn gyfoethog o fod wedi etifeddu cryn dipyn o arian, ac mae sawl dyn yn dymuno ei phriodi. Ond mae hi mewn cariad â’r gwehydd basgedi tlawd, Vincent. Yn yr valseariette ystwyth hon, mae Mireille yn galw ar y wennol wibiog i hedfan yn llawen at ei hanwylyd a chyhoeddi ei chariad wrtho. Holwyd i Gounod ychwanegu’r darn hwn gan ddehonglydd cyntaf y rhan hon, Caroline Carvalho, er mwyn cydfynd â’i harddull coloratura.

Cleopatra has been captured by her treacherous brother, Tolomeo, but her lover Caesar liberates her before she can be thrown into prison. Cleopatra sings of the battle that will follow, sure of Caesar’s victory

Susanna, recently married to Figaro, is plotting with the Countess, her employer, to trick the Count into thinking that Susanna will meet him in the garden for a romantic assignation. Susanna knows that Figaro is hiding in the shadows, spying on her, so she decides to teach him a lesson for doubting her fidelity. She calls for her lover not to delay and to come to meet her among the rose bushes.

In ‘The rose ribbon’, the singer finds his beloved, asleep in the spring shade. He binds her up in rose-coloured ribbons and gazes upon her as she sleeps. He whispers to her and rustles the ribbons and when she wakes up and gazes at him, he is in heaven. The poem is by Klopstock.

Mireille is a rich heiress, with several men wanting to marry her. But she is in love with a poor basketweaver, Vincent. In this agile valse ariette, Mireille calls upon the nimble swallow to fly joyfully to her beloved and tell him that she loves him. Gounod was asked to include this by the first interpreter of the title role, Caroline Carvalho, to suit her coloratura technique.

Sister Angelica of the opera's title has lived in a convent for seven years, having been forced to take the veil by her family after giving birth to an illegitimate child. Here, she has just learned that her son has died. Overcome by grief, Sister Angelica laments that her baby died without his mother and decides to take her own life so she can join her son in heaven.

Cleopatra believes that the battle is over and that Caesar is dead. In this famous aria, set to a quatrain, she mourns with great bitterness and promises that in death she will become a ghost and haunt the enemy night and day.

Donna Anna is mourning the death of her father, the Commendatore, who has been murdered by Don Giovanni. Donna Anna's betrothed, Don Ottavio, is putting pressure on her to become his wife, but she asks him not to speak of marriage while she is still full of grief.

George Ireland graduated with Distinction from the Royal College of Music, where he studied Collaborative Piano with Simon Lepper and Roger Vignoles. His studies were supported by the Kendall-Taylor award, Pimlott Foundation, Hervey Benham Charitable Trust and Tom Acton Memorial Trust.

He is from a non-musical background and only began to play the piano, self taught and from scratch, at the age of 14. Now 26, he enjoys a busy career as an in-demand collaborative pianist in this country and abroad.

In 2019 he was involved in a Lieder project exploring the music of Emigre composer Robert Kahn, and enjoyed performances at the RCM, the German Embassy in London and the Akademie Der Künste in Berlin. He recently gave his first performance of Schubert's Winterreise in Bielefeld with soprano Daniela Bechley, which was reviewed in Neue Westfälische:

"Those present experienced how the singer and pianist explored this dark and powerful cycle, and that two people had captured a timelessly significant masterpiece entirely in its essential core. They had not only the musical class, but also the inner relationship to interpret the 'Winterreise' movingly."

George is a Leeds Lieder Young Artist, and at the 2019 festival enjoyed masterclasses with mezzo-soprano Laura Fleur given by Ann Murray and Amanda Roccoft. He has since enjoyed masterclasses with Helmut Deutsch, Roderick Williams and Dame Sarah Connolly.

In 2020 George accompanied Jessica Cale in her Kathleen Ferrier Award-winning performance, and they enjoy a fruitful ongoing partnership.

César Cañón alternates his activities as a pianist and conductor with teaching and vocal coaching. He has performed and collaborated on stages in his native Colombia, as well as in Brazil, Canada, Italy, Mexico, Norway and across the United States. Cañón holds degrees in piano performance from the National University of Colombia and in Collaborative Piano from the University of Michigan, where he obtained a Masters and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees under the mentorship of celebrated pianist Martin Katz.

He is also an alumn of the Aspen Opera Theatre Center, the Merola Opera Program and San Francisco Opera's Adler Fellowship. He has been a guest lecturer and performer in several universities in Colombia and across the United States, including residencies at Michigan State University, University of Michigan, Emory University, and the University of Texas at Austin. Julian was a member of Welsh National Opera for many years, both as Chorus Master and Head of Music. As a conductor he specialised in Italian repertoire, particularly the bel canto period and Puccini, and conducted over forty operas for WNO. As a guest conductor he performed with Opera Australia, Scottish Opera, Vancouver Opera, Iceland Opera, the New Zealand Opera, Glyndebourne Touring Opera, Opera Zuid and the San Francisco Opera. Julian has conducted concerts featuring many distinguished singers, including Bryn Terfel, Renée Fleming, Dennis O'Neill and Sherrill Milnes.

He has conducted frequently for television and has recorded recital albums with the Orchestra of Welsh National Opera. As a musicologist Julian Smith reconstructed the original version of Madama Butterfly. He has appeared for many North American companies notably the Metropolitan Opera, San Francisco Opera and Chicago Lyric Opera.

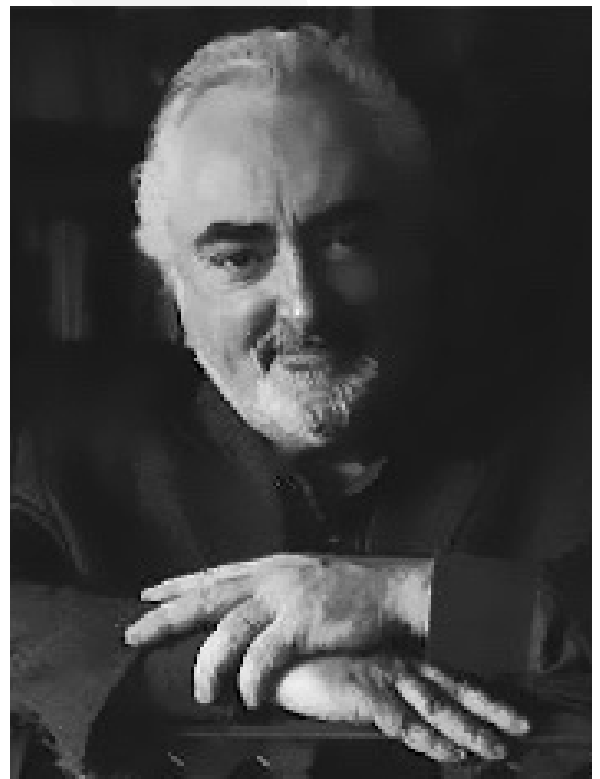

Yn dilyn cyfnod fel golygydd gyda Gwasg Prifysgol Rhydychen ymunodd â'r BBC ym 1971 fel cynhyrchydd gyda Radio 3 ac yn ystod gyrfa 20-mlynedd o hyd gyda'r BBC daeth yn Brif Gynhyrchydd Opera ac yn gyflwynydd a darlledwr adnabyddus. Ym 1982 cafodd ei phenodi yn gyfarwyddwr Artistig Gŵyl Opera Wexford yn Iwerddon, ac yn ystod ei chyfnod o 13-mlynedd yn y swydd llwyfannwyd 40 o operâu prin. He was Head of Music Staff at the Grand Théâtre de Genève 1989-96, assisting conductors such as Tate, Patané, Jordan, Bartoletti, Thielemann, Plasson, Elder, de Waart, Bertini and Campanella. He has worked as assistant conductor/senior coach with companies including Opéra National de Paris, Dutch National Opera, Royal Danish Opera, Opera di Roma, Teatro San Carlo di Napoli, Théâtre Capitole de Toulouse, Teatro Real di Madrid and the Festivals of Aix-en-Provence, Chorégies de Orange, Salzburg and Wexford. He was senior coach on The Ring under Jeffrey Tate in Australia. He has conducted Die Dreigroschenoper for RADA. Concert work has included the Edinburgh and Aldeburgh Festivals and the BBC Proms. He is a visiting tutor at the National Opera Studio, British Youth Opera, Scottish Opera Emerging Artists, New National Theatre Tokyo and all the major British conservatoires. He is a regular jury member for national and international competitions and has given masterclasses throughout Europe, Latin America, the Far East, Australia and South Africa. He has been associated with the Young Artists Programme at the Royal Opera House since its inception in 2000, initially as Director of Musical Preparation and from 2006 as Artistic Director, and regularly accompanies the Jette Parker Young Artists in recitals. Recent collaborations on the concert platform include Nelly Miricioiu at St John's Smith Square, Eri Nakamura in Tokyo and Osaka and Dušica Bijelić and Haoyin Xue in Nanjing and Beijing.

Elaine Padmore read music at Birmingham University and the Guildhall, and began her career as a singer, répétiteur and writer, becoming a lecturer in operatic history at the Royal Academy of Music. After a period as an editor at Oxford University Press, she joined the BBC in 1971 as a Radio 3 producer and, during a 20-year career at the BBC, became Chief Producer of Opera and was well known as a presenter and broadcaster. In 1982 she was appointed Artistic Director of Ireland's Wexford Festival Opera where her 13-year tenure saw the production of 40 rare operas. She also became involved in running large-scale opera such as the Harvey Goldsmith productions of Tosca and Carmen at Earl's Court Arena. From 1993 to 2000, she lived in Copenhagen as Artistic Director of the Royal Danish Opera, a period acclaimed as being of unprecedented growth in the Company's international reputation. In 2000 she was appointed Director of Opera at the newly reopened Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, a post she held until retirement in 2011 and where, amongst her many other achievements, she initiated the Young Artists Programme. A Board member of British Youth Opera and a Trustee of the Countess of Munster Musical Trust, she has served on many musical juries, including BBC Cardiff Singer of the World, the Kathleen Ferrier, Richard Tauber, and Luciano Pavarotti Awards.
